## Using The USAWOA Interactive Portal for 39<sup>th</sup> AMM Registration

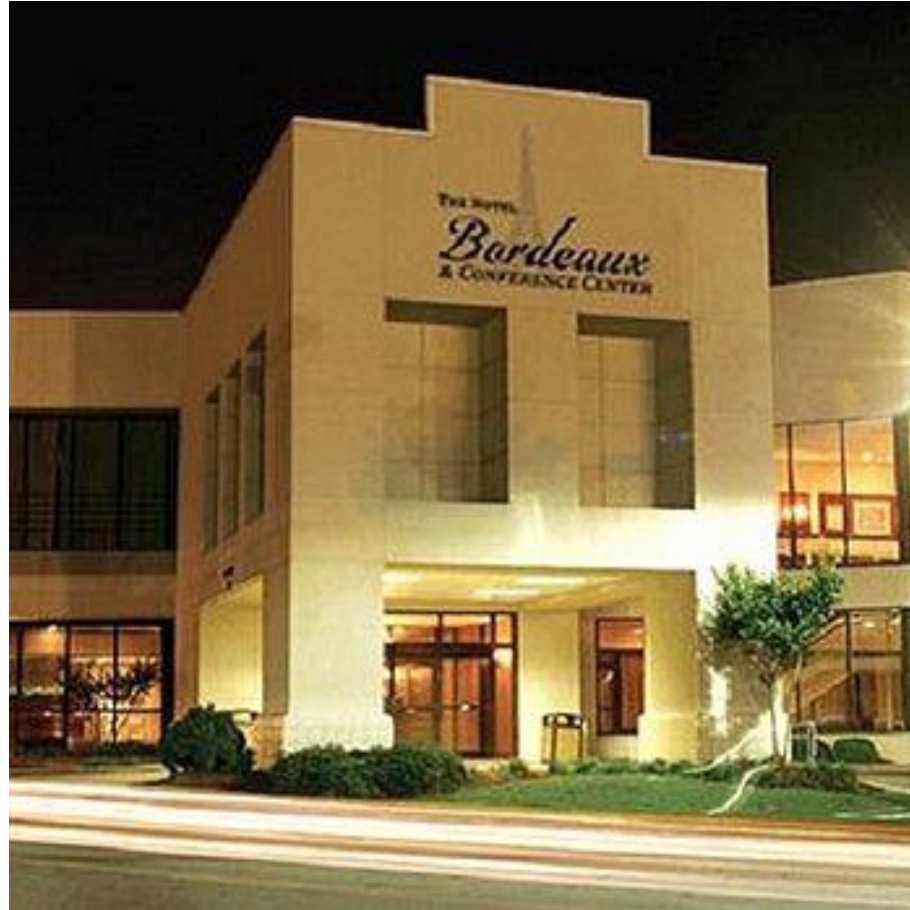
**AMM and Ball** - This year the USAWOA membership will be able to register Online to attend the **39<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the Members (AMM) and/or the 39<sup>th</sup> AMM Banquet/Ball** using the Online Store in the USAWOA Interactive Portal web site <https://usawoa.net> (shortcut link to Portal). Log-In with your Log-In and Password. Next click on **Renewals & Online Store** and click on the orange Select button to the right of the 39<sup>th</sup> AMM (first item in Online Store). You will see your name and the registration fee to attend the AMM. Verify your name and click the Next button. Now verify your name for the registration badge and click the Next button. If this is the first time attending a USAWOA AMM click the First Time block. On the next screen, select the events you plan to attend from October 17-20, 2011. Under October 21, 2011, select the **AMM Awards Banquet/Ball - Member** and then select your **meal for the Banquet/Ball**. Click the Next button and select from the dropdown how many Guests you will have and click the Next button. On the next screen, fill in the name of your Guest for the registration badge in capital letters, City and State. If this is the first time attending a USAWOA AMM, click the **First Time** block and click the Next button. Now verify your guest name for the registration badge and click Next. Look to the right of the Select Sessions for Guest Registration name and click on the **double dropdown arrows**. Now select which events your guest plans on attending from October 17-20, 2011. Under October 21, 2011, select the **AMM Awards Banquet/Ball – Spouse/Guest** and then select your spouse **meal for the Banquet/Ball** and click the Next button. The next screen will show the cost of the member and guest for the AMM Registration. If the fees and events are correct click the **Register Now button**. This will place the member and guest AMM registration fees in the shopping cart. Now you are ready to **Check Out** by clicking on **Check Out** and follow the instruction to complete the payment for the Banquet/Ball fees. After paying for your registration fees, make sure you Logout.

**Banquet/Ball Only** - If you are only attending the **39<sup>th</sup> USAWOA Banquet/Ball** click on the Select button to the right of the 39<sup>th</sup> AMM Banquet/Ball (second item in Online Store). Next you will see your name and the registration fee to attend the **39<sup>th</sup> AMM Banquet/Ball**. Verify your name and click on the **Select Meal for Banquet**. Select your meal choice (mandatory) and click the Next button. On the next screen select from the dropdown how many Guests you will have and click the Next button. On the next screen fill in the name of your Guest for the registration badge in capital letters. Fill in the City and State (mandatory) blocks. Select your guest meal choice (mandatory) and click the Next button. Verify the spelling of your guest name, the cost and click the Next button. If everything is correct click on Register Now. Now you are ready to **Check Out** by clicking on **Check Out** and follow the instruction to complete the payment for the Banquet/Ball fees. After paying for your registration fees make sure you Logout.

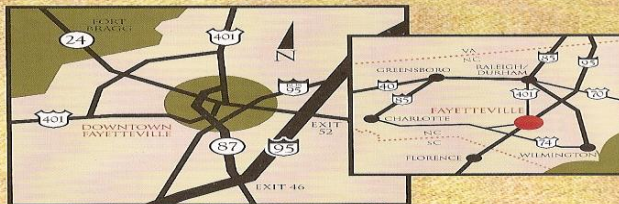

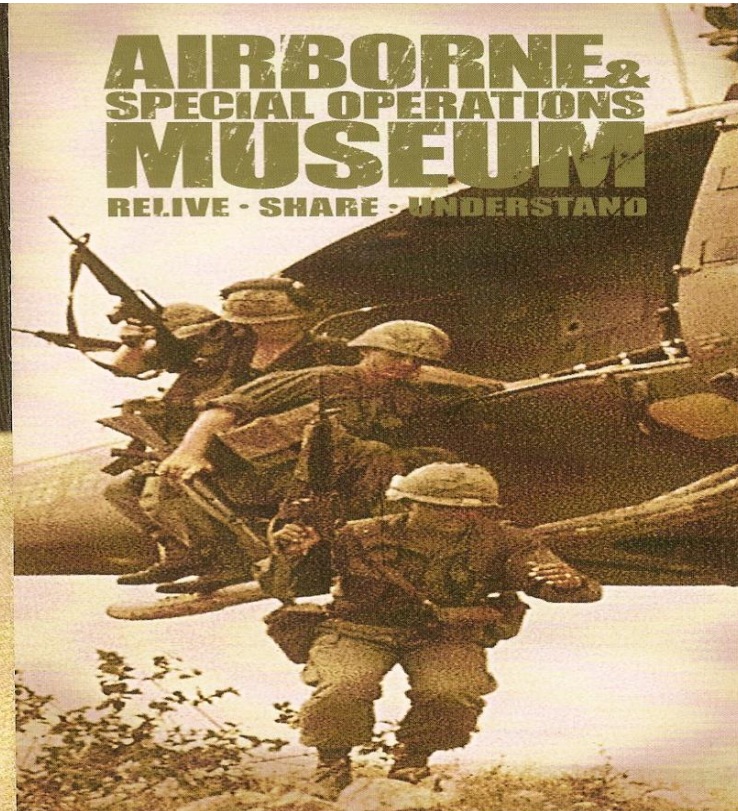
